We now stock the full range of gorgeous hand dyed stranded cottons by Cottage Garden Threads. These threads are lovely to stitch with and the finished work really is beautiful.

We also have stranded DMC floss and Threadworks overdyed threads.

New to the shop, is the most delicious hand dyed silk

ribbons that you have ever seen! To be perfectly honest with you, the main reason that I got these ribbons was because I needed to have the display ring—it is just too pretty! Ribbons are available in 4 different sizes 2mm, 4mm, 7mm and 13mm and prices range from

\$3.95, \$4.40, \$5.50 and \$7.70 respectively. A great thread conditioner is Thread Heaven. It extends the lifetime of thread and the finished items that you have made, protects against UV damage, mould and mildew and reduces tangling whilst you are stitching. Only \$6,95 a block (that lasts for an age!)

Neenies Garden is an 11 part block of the month program. It is \$44 per month and includes everything you will need to complete the top of the quilt. To ease you into the whole idea, I have some great little colourque taster kits for you to learn on. Each kit has an iron-on transfer

design, fabric, several pencils and fabric medium. The kits cost \$25. Other designs are available separately for \$10.50 each. The completed designs can be used in any number of small projects. Be warned though...this is very relaxing and you will struggle to stop for normal activities like eating, sleeping and day-time jobs.





The wish list... Here is how to use it to your best advantage!


- Print off page 4 of this newsletter.
